PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist with conducting the JA BizTown and/or JA Finance Park simulations as assigned by the Director of Capstone Programs, including:
 - Emcee the on-site simulation with natural stage present in front of large groups (50-150 students and volunteers);
 - Work with smaller groups of students to ensure understanding of concepts;
 - Provide technical support and trouble shoot common issues with simulation software and/or storefront technology;
 - Create a positive experience for students, teachers, and volunteers in partnership with other JA staff.
- Assist with leading on-site volunteer training.
- Ensure the facility is adequately prepared and stocked for simulation each morning; reset the facility each day for the next day's students.

- Other responsibilities as assigned.
